The **Mill Creek Colliery Band** will start its 2009-2010 season by presenting "**A Tribute in Brass**", an all-brass concert to be performed on Saturday, November 7th, 7:30pm, at McDougall United Church (10025 – 101 Street, Edmonton).

Edmonton's own 28-piece, British-style brass band will present an exciting, brassy variety of music. The program will feature the world premiere of *Suite of Dances from "Terpsichore"*, a new arrangement by the world-renowned Edmonton composer, Dr. Malcolm Forsyth, who is also the conductor of the band. Other musical gems on the program include *Canadian Folk Song Suite* (Calvert), *Celebrate Rotary* (Graham), *The Lord of the Rings: Return of the King* (arr. Harper), *Hungarian Dance No. 5* (Brahms/Elson) and *Yellow Submarine* (Lennon & McCartney/Catherall). Our featured soloists are Chris Diaper (euphonium) in *Solo Rhapsody for Euphonium* (Stephens) and Cam Martin (soprano cornet) in *Concertino for E-flat Cornet* (Sachse). The band dedicates this concert to the memory of its friend and long-time compère, Dr. David Cook, who recently passed away.

The band will be led by principal conductor, Dr. Malcolm Forsyth, and Sir Francis Price will be our compère.
