The **Mill Creek Colliery Band** will start its 2008-2009 season by presenting "***Tiddly-Pom Brass***", an all-brass concert to be performed on Saturday, November 8<sup>th</sup>, 7:30pm, at Convocation Hall (University of Alberta, Arts Building – Edmonton, Alberta).

Edmonton's own 28-piece, British-style brass band will present an exciting, brassy variety of music. The program will feature the world premiere of *Rondino Tiddly-Pom*, a new work by the world-renowned Edmonton composer, Dr. Malcolm Forsyth, who is also the conductor of the band. This piece features Suzanne Langor on tenor horn and Cam Martin on soprano cornet. Other musical gems on the program include *Lawrence of Arabia* (Jarre/Mortimer), *Summon The Dragon* (Graham), *Shine As The Light* (Graham), the march favorite - *The Stars and Stripes Forever*, and an unusual upbeat arrangement of Bach's *Tocatta in D Minor*. Our bass section will be featured in the toe-tapping *Tyrolean Tubas* (Clark), and other soloists include Chris Diaper (euphonium) in *Midnight Euphonium* (Richards) and David Langor (cornet) in *Share My Yoke* (Webb/Bosanko).

The band will be led by principal conductor, Dr. Malcolm Forsyth, and Dr. David Cook will be our compère.
