The featured soloists are: Mike Rowe (soprano cornet) and Shannon Hoople (cornet) playing *The Flower Duet from Lakme* (Delibes/Sparke) and David Langor (cornet) playing *Ducky* (Bones/Baker). As usual, there will be some favourite Proms sing-alongs.

The band will be led by its principal conductor, David Hoyt.
