Bill Dimmer has been described as a “cornerstone” of Edmonton’s music scene. Between his arrival in 1971 and his retirement from the Edmonton Symphony Orchestra in 2014, Bill served as a teacher, mentor, administrator, conductor, and performer. He also played an important role in creating the ESO’s educational concert series. Bill is also an active air crew member and instructor with the Civil Air Search and Rescue Association and teaches ground school at the Edmonton Flying Club.

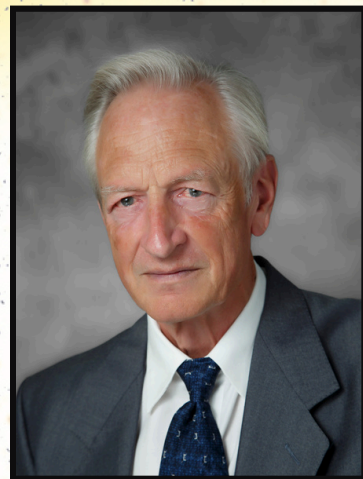

CONDUCTOR

David Hoyt has studied piano, French horn and worked with several renowned mentors. He joined the Edmonton Symphony Orchestra (ESO) while a student at the University of Alberta, becoming principal horn in 1975. David became assistant conductor of the ESO in 1985 and of the Canadian Opera Company in 1991. He has been a guest conductor with many orchestras and ensembles in Canada and the USA. David has a long association with The Banff Centre as a visiting artist and faculty member and, from 2004 - 2005, as Artistic Director/Executive Director of "Music and Sound". He spent 10 years teaching horn at the University of Alberta and has taught across the country at many festivals and music camps. As the head of Education and Outreach at the ESO, David expanded and founded several popular concert series. David has been principal conductor of the Mill Creek Colliery Band since 2012.
