David Hoyt has studied piano, French horn and worked with several renowned mentors. He joined the Edmonton Symphony Orchestra (ESO) while a student at the University of Alberta, becoming principal horn in 1975. David became assistant conductor of the ESO in 1985 and of the Canadian Opera Company in 1991. He has been a guest conductor with many orchestras and ensembles in Canada and the USA. He spent 10 years teaching horn at the University of Alberta and has taught across the country at many festivals and music camps. David has been principal conductor of the Mill Creek Colliery Band since 2012.

KRISTIN FLORES

Canadian composer Kristin Flores is captivated by the beauty of sound. She loves the way that different intervals have an effect on the listener – the frustration that dissonance creates and the calm of consonance. She looks for melodies that will take root in the listener's mind so that they will carry the melodies with them long after the piece is finished. She uses musical materials to explore the beauty of nature as well as her thoughts and emotions.

ALBERTA HABITATS AND AT-RISK SPECIES – BRASS BAND COMPOSITION (2025)

Commissioned by the Mill Creek Colliery Brass Band with support from the Alberta Foundation for the Arts. At the core of this work is transcription: transforming the sounds of Alberta's at-risk species — their breaths, calls, growls, and rhythms — into brass band music. Each movement captures both the animal's sonic character and its surrounding habitat, creating a dialogue between musicians and the natural world.

Alberta Habitats and At-Risk Species – Brass Band Composition (2025) is both celebration and elegy: a celebration of Alberta's extraordinary biodiversity, and an elegy for the species and ecosystems that stand on the brink of disappearance.
